Intern Option Students: Requirements for Education Courses

Intern Option students (those who do not possess a valid Instructional I or II teaching certificate from the Pennsylvania Department of Education) must take up to five courses in education to meet requirements for certification in Library Science, K-12, depending on education previously completed: one course in educational psychology; one course in education and society; and three courses in curriculum and teaching methods.

These courses may be taken at the undergraduate or graduate level at a college or university near the student, at an institution that offers such courses online, or on campus in the School of Education; each student consults with the SLCP Director to seek approval of the courses in advance of registering for the courses. When the student completes these courses, the student submits a transcript to the Director of the SLCP to verify that this requirement is completed successfully.
